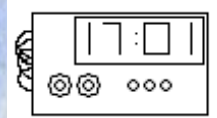
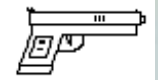

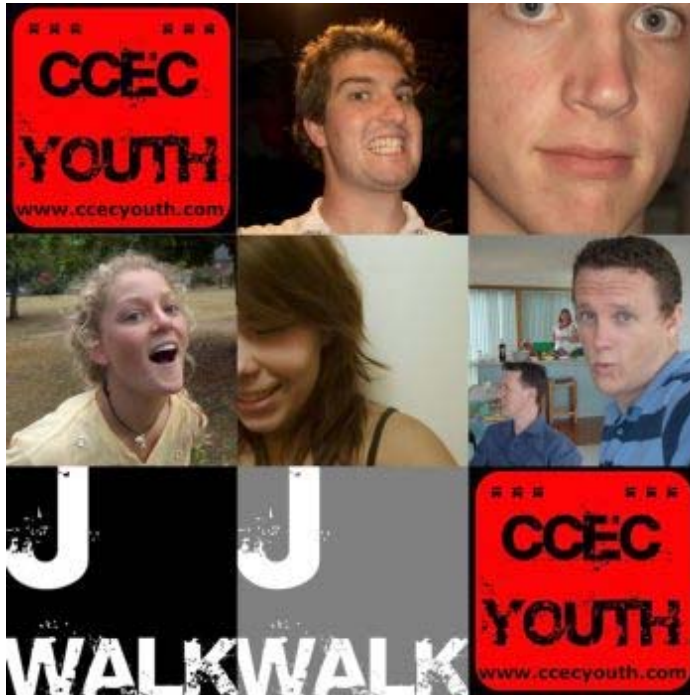

Well-known philosopher Woody Allen says: "You can't ride two horses with one bum." Even better known Saviour of the world Jesus says: "You can't serve two masters."

You can't do either.

You can't ride two horses with one bum.

You can't serve two masters. Jesus says that you will either love one and hate the other or be devoted to one and despise the other.

A Christian is someone who turns away from serving other masters to serve the living and true God—Jesus.

On PHAT over the last two years we have been learning about how to turn from a number of idols that are common to teenagers.

More important than the idols that we are turning from, is what we are turning to, and why we are doing it.

Why turn away from idols to serve Jesus? Because Jesus is supreme!! Jesus is the true and living God. Jesus is our creator. Jesus is our redeemer.

The big question we asked through the night talks on PHAT 2006 and PHAT 2007 was: **WHO WILL BE YOUR GOD?**

The following is a recap of the idols that will compete for out attention in life. Below each idol is a verse that help us to think through who our God will be. I hope this is a helpful refresher.

1. IT'S NOT ALL ABOUT ME: *turning from the idol of SELF*

And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again. (2 Cor 5:15)

2. SERVING ONE MASTER: *turning from the idol of STUFF*

No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money. (Matt 6:24)

3. PLEASING GOD: *turning from the idol of SEX*

We instructed you how to live in order to please God, as in fact you are living. Now we ask you and urge you in the Lord Jesus to do this more and more. (1 Thess 4:1)

4. SET YOUR MIND ON THINGS ABOVE: *turning from the idol of SELEBRITY*

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. (Col 3:1-4)

5. GODLINESS LASTS 4EVA: *turning from the idol of SPORT*

For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come.

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(1 Timothy 4:8)

6. DON'T LOVE THE WORLD: *turning from the idol of SUCCESS*

Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For everything in the world – the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does – comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever. (1 John 2:15-17)

Who will be your God?

- Self?
- Stuff?
- Sex?
- Celebrity?
- Sport?
- Success?

Or Jesus?

In 1 Thessalonians, Paul speaks about how the church in Thessalonica has become well known because of the way that they responded to Jesus.

They tell how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead – Jesus, who rescues us from the coming wrath.

(1 Thess 1:9-10)

How did they respond to Jesus?

- Turn.
- Serve.
- Wait.

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They **TURNE**d away from their idols, to **SERVE** the living and true God and are **WAITING** for Jesus to return.

I would love our youth group to be a place well-known for having many teenagers on the Central Coast turn away from false idols to serve the true and living God—JESUS—our Risen King who rescues us from the penalty we deserve.

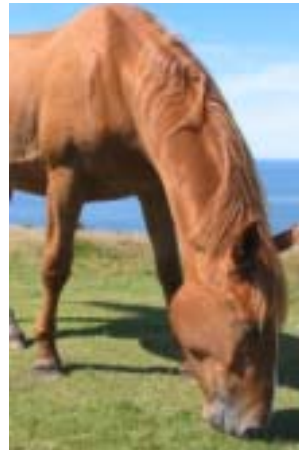
Who are you serving?

The lights were dimmed the stage was set and I'm already running out of clichéd band references, however that's anything but what *Tammy and the Wolverines* were, derivative yes, clichéd and unoriginal, definitely not. Flashbacks from the 80's were unavoidable looking around the crowded hall. Everyone it seemed had traveled back in time for one night only. It was a mass of big hair, fluoro attire and leg warmers, all in all some very questionable fashion choices. Anticipation mounted as *Tammy* was expected to begin, many staked out places at the front trying to get the best view or be the closest to the band all the while twitching with excitement.

Through coloured lights and a cloud of smoke came the beginning bars of 'You Give Love a Bad Name', the music becoming almost indistinguishable over the sounds of screaming. The set was classically 80's with each member adopting a different instrument for every song. Thus demonstrating their suburb and eclectic talents for which they are known. According to Vincent "The band and all the instruments

are like a piece of bread, and we just spread ourselves over it", and well they did spread.

The interesting thing about U.K band Tammy and the Wolverines is their commitment to their craft. Their manner and way of life shows their dedication to remaining true to 80's rock. "We're in the 80's, we pretty much stopped at 1985, that was the pinnacle of human existence and that's where we choose to stop." Vincent stated confidently in the bands interview with Paddy host Dave Miers after the event. The band consists of Billy Fury, Sledge, Vincent, Danny all who hail from England and Lucius the only Welsh member. Painfully aware of their own talents and not by any means shy at showing it Billy Fury stated "I didn't choose to be a musician, musicianship choose me" and this according to Sledge has become a proverb for the whole band. The group has been playing together for centuries since almost the beginning of time it may seem, "in the beginning God created the Heavens and the Earth and the 80's" which is the gospel according to Billy. Their long standing as a band unquestionably shows by their refined sound and sophisticated act. That's not to say that the

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boys don't have fun with stories surrounding their name including random shouting out Tammy all at the same time, and the trial of a wolverine band member, who just couldn't let go of Billy's belly, it's safe to assume that it's been an interesting ride for these lads.

It was a new experience for Tammy as they were told about God by Dave accepting they often try to be God every night on stage, with Billy admitting, "sometimes I do things I probably shouldn't do I guess." It was the explanation of God's love prompting him to send his son so that we might have a relationship with him that really provoked a response from the boys. Sledge said 'sounds like Jesus rocks', and Vincent seemed to agree with his statement, "if we're going to be a supporting act for anybody aye It may as well be him."

The live act came to a close with "Living on a Prayer" and while it was obvious the crowd wanted more a broken string meant the night must end. Tammy and the Wolverines strutted from the stage to the same reception that they walked onto, shouting parting words to all the dedicated fans and really what could be more exciting that a *cute* boy from a band saying you had been a part of the hottest crowd he had ever seen? Band: Anberlin
 Album: Cities

The beginning of this Anberlin's 3rd album, Cities, is like a dance party signalling good times to come. Godspeed is the perfect opener as it's built on adrenalin and meant to be played loudly. The hook from the song is defiantly one which gets listeners - 'they lied when they said the good died young.' Lyrically in each song there is there a message about social reflection which has often been unflatteringly labelled preachy God rock. While there are subtle Christian messages throughout about salvation and love as in Unwinding Cable Car, (unquestionably the best acoustic song on the CD) these messages, while key to the atmosphere, do not sound preachy at all. Unwinding Cable Car is one of those songs you just want to have on repeat until you know all the words by heart. There is a new tone introduced in this song which is carried throughout the album, differing from what was at times a little too poppy in the previous albums. It is a very emotional album, conveyed through the extreme sincerity of the lyrics as well as the large acoustic sections. At the close of the album is Fin. beginning with two or so minutes of instrumental with slight distortion. As the lyrics and choir come in its hard not to be mesmerised by this soulful song. It is the perfect finish to an album which discussed how sins like skeletons are hard to hide and questions, to whom we assume is God, at the conclusion 'Aren't we all to you just lost causes, are we all to you lost?' This is something to reflect on as Christians as we struggle with sin in our own lives and endeavour to not loose sight of God as number one above all else.

DVD REVIEW:

Series: Sliders
 Seasons: 1995-2000



Ok who remembers Sliders? Probably all the 80's born kids who grew up in the 90's. It was beyond a doubt one of the coolest shows ever. Granted I am a self confessed nerd, I love star trek and all the sweet sci-fi good times but please don't dismiss the greatness the Sliders series had to offer you. For those of you who are unaware of what Sliders is even about here is a

brief summary. Quinn Mallory (Jerry O'Connel now from Crossing Jordan but previously Jerry McGuire and Scream 2) a graduate student working on an anti-gravity device accidentally opens a portal to another dimension where it's the same time on earth but everything else is different. After and initial test with himself, Wade Wells (played by Sabrina Llyod), Prof. Professor Maximillian Arturo and The 'Crying Man' Rembrandt Brown they find themselves stranded unable to reach their Earth and continue to slide through parallel earth in an attempt to get home. The first two series' are largely about what would happen if social norms were different or if certain historical events hadn't happened. The third season however saw a shift and delved into more relational aspects and action based circumstances, this was however not taken into the fourth and fifth seasons. The concept of doubles is largely explored throughout the series, as is the notion of right and wrong which sometimes seems skewed depending on which world they slide to. There is always the consistency that the sliders must do what is right, which often ends with them helping individuals of the new world with drastic consequences. They, however, continue to treat new individuals they encounter with respect and love which is something we talked about at PHAT from 1 Thessalonians. Paul urges us in 1 Thess. 5: 12-16 Respect those who labour amount you and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, and to esteem them very highly in love because of their work. Be at peace among yourselves as we urge you brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the faint-hearted help the weak, be patient with them all. See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone. The last section there shows that we should have unconditional love even for those we may not want to, and this is something to work on everyday
